

Star of David Suncatcher

Learn how to cut a Star of David pattern here.

Each suncatcher needs 2 stars cut from yellow construction paper or any heavier yellow paper.

Now for the “Stained Glass”.

You will need:

liquid starch

colored tissue paper

waxed paper

paint- or craft brush

Cut a piece of waxed paper the same size as your star pattern. Use this for the base. Cover the work area with newspaper and tape the waxed paper down to keep it from shifting when brushed.

Tear pieces of tissue into small pieces.

Use the paintbrush to brush liquid starch all over the surface of the waxed paper.

Set a piece of tissue into the starch. Arrange the colored tissue artfully until the entire star is covered. Gently brush more starch over the tissue.

Allow starch to dry, then glue the stained glass between the two stars.

Punch a hole at the point of one star and string a piece of yarn or or thread to serve as a hanger.
